The biggest troublemaker you'll probably ever have to deal with, watches you from the mirror every month.


Letting the cat outta the bag is a lot easier than putting it back in.

SUMMER HEAT MEANS KEEP IT COOL



Having fun in the sun could result in heatstroke. This happens when a dog's body can't dissipate heat fast enough in the usual ways: by panting to cool her blood or through the skin, mainly on the face, ears and feet. If their body temperature rises past 104 degrees, your dog may slow down, become weak, or collapse. If it

rises past 109 degrees, your dog can die. Take steps to prevent this from happening, NEVER leave your dog unsupervised in a car and keep the time limited that they are exposed to direct sunlight. Also make sure that they have plenty of water and shade. Some dogs require extra care, the very young, under 6 months, overweight and senior

dogs; dogs ill with any long term disease, i.e. heart disease, etc. and brachycephalic breeds, like the bulldog and pug.. Mild heatstroke is treated with rest in a cool room with fresh water. Listen for labored breathing or excessive panting. If you see these symptoms cover the dog with a cool towel. If your dogs rectal temp goes above 105 call the vet.

Follow from * above


Parking will probably be on the side of our house (Turner Lane). Gianna and Steve will direct parking that day.


